## **Chappell Hill Garden Club Annual Meeting**

The Chappell Hill Garden Club Annual Meeting opened at 10:02. Present were 25 members.

**Financial Reports** Lynda Harrison presented the 2020 financial reports, which are attached to the original minutes. The net loss for 2020 was \$493.50, which was \$1,530.56 better than budgeted.

The home tour netted \$12,350.15.

The combined bank balances at 12/31/2020 was \$25,709.83.

Lynda presented the 2021 budget, which is attached to the original minutes and available on the website.

Lynda went through the budget, highlighting important information. The budget for Scholarships is \$9,000, which is an increase of \$3,000 over the 2020 budget. The budget for Programs is \$2,000, which is an increase of \$1,000 over the 2020 budget. The increase is due to the cost of a bus for a field trip to Moody Gardens.

The budget results in a loss of \$5,894 in 2021. Lynda explained that the club has excess cash that needs to be drawn down.

Dale Dugas moved that the budget be accepted as presented. Virginia Malinowski seconded, and the motion carried.

<u>President's Report on 2020</u> Dale Ramey reported the club provided \$5,500 in scholarships in 2020. An additional \$874.85 was spent on community outreach, providing meals for health care workers at the DaVita Brenham

Dialysis, St. Joseph Family Medicine Brenham and Brenham Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Dale Ramey thanked Debi Faver for the beautiful beds on Main Street, and Debbie Roberts for the lovely Memory Garden.

Other highlights in 2020 included a successful home tour, and an enjoyable plant exchange.

Dale Dugas moved that the actions of the Board of Directors for the year 2020 be approved. Virginia Malinowski seconded, and the motion passed.

Carol Madeley moved to adjourn; Shirley Rigamonti seconded, and the meeting adjourned at 10:23.
