The possibility of

including the Rock Store on the tour for the rugs and the contest next year was suggested. Additional advertising was recommended for 2021, including banners over the road near HEB in Brenham.

Dale moved that a \$100 donation be given to Washington County Citizens on Patrol to thank them for their help directing traffic. Carol seconded the motion, which passed.

Being no further business, Bennie moved to adjourn; Lynda seconded, and the meeting adjourned at 4:55 pm.
