

Chappell Hill Garden Club Board

August 3, 2020

The Chappell Hill Garden Club Board meeting began at 2:35. Present were Bennie Yates, Karen Kubeczka, Lynda Harrison, Carol Madeley, Dale Ramey, and Paula Barrett. Dale Dugas was invited to report on sponsorships for the home tour but was unable to come.

A voting box will be at the church for home tour visitors to vote on the best tree, which will be announced at the Christmas party.

Membership Application Karen updated the membership application, which will be available on the website.

Programs The cooking classes in La Grange were a big success. The possibility of another cooking class in 2021, perhaps at the church, was discussed.

The October field trip to the Dallas Arboretum is cancelled. The program for the October meeting is open.

Loyce Jardell will not be Program Chair again in 2021. Possible replacements were discussed. Dale will talk to Nikki Thornton and Debbie Roberts about chairing the committee and ask for volunteers at the August meeting.

Treasurer Lynda Harrison reported the combined balance of the two bank accounts as of July 31, 2020, was \$17,878.83. Through July, total income was \$1,791.72 and total expenses were \$9,313.88, for a net loss of \$7,522.16. Complete financial reports are attached to the original minutes.
