

Chappell Hill Garden Club Board

June 1, 2021

The Chappell Hill Garden Club Board meeting opened at 2:28. Present were Carol Madeley, Dale Ramey, Karen Kubeczka, Shirley Rigamonti and Dale Dugas.

Quorum was established.

Sponsorship Dale Dugas gave a report on sponsorship for the home tour. She will begin working on sponsors in August. There was discussion about possible new sponsors. Members will be asked for their suggestions at the June meeting.

Lynda Harrison called into the meeting to ask Dale Dugas about the status of advertising on Facebook and Instagram promised to 2020 sponsors who donated \$500 or more. Dale Dugas had forgotten about it but would work on it soon. She agreed to advertise for the 2021 sponsors as well.

Programs Candice Bullock, county commissioner, will speak at the June meeting. Members were asked to provide questions for Candice. Shirley said she had received about 18 questions from 6 members.

There was discussion about the July meeting, when Connie Wilder from Funky Art Café will give a cooking presentation. The board agreed they would prefer a program involving herbs, rather than a dessert. Shirley will work with Connie on the program.

In August, Texas Brigade will provide the program.

Dale Ramey suggested members speak briefly at meetings about their gardens.

The Moody Garden trip was tabled for 2021.

Treasurer's Report Lynda Harrison submitted financial reports through May 2021, which are attached to the original minutes. The combined bank balance at May 31, 2021 was \$19,931.83, consisting of \$15,991.78 in the

savings account and \$3,940.05 in the operating account. Net income through May 2021 was a loss of \$5,337.16.

Two scholarship checks have been written so far each for \$1,500, one to Ileesha Bradford and the other to Katie Murski. Lynda filed the 990-N tax return. Budgets are in line.

Home Tour Two homes are secured for the 2021 home tour: Dixie Ford's and her neighbor's home. Dale Ramey has visited the homes. Two to three more homes are needed. There was discussion about possibilities.

Standing Rules There was discussion about Standing Rule 9, which says "Field trips and all outside events including the Christmas party are for members only and are not open to guests." A decision about changing the rule will be made when the full board is present.

The next board meeting will be on July 6, starting earlier at 1:30, to ensure the board has time to discuss all issues.

Karen moved to adjourn; Shirley seconded, and the meeting adjourned at 3:28 pm.
