

# Digging Fall

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<b>Flowers</b>	<b>Planting / Pruning</b>
<b>Roses</b>	Prune and fertilize in late August, early September for Fall bloom
<b>Wildflowers</b>	Sow seed September thru early December for spring bloom
<b>Perennials</b>	Divide Spring blooms such as Iris, Daylily, and Shasta Daisy as needed every 3 to 4 years. Plant for Mums, Verbena, Cone Flowers, Salvias etc.
<b>Annuals</b>	Fall color September- Petunias, Dianthus October- Pansies, Snapdragons, Violas, Johnny-jump-up, Stock, Calendula and Sweet Peas
<b>Bulbs</b> <b>Fall Planting</b>	Dutch Iris, Anemone, Ranunculus, Daffodil, Hyacinth and more.
<b>Trees &amp; Shrubs</b>	
All Trees And Shrubs in containers may be planted	

<b>Veggies For Fall Seeds</b>	Bush Beans Beets-thru mid-October Cabbage- to November Collards-to December Lettuce (leaf)-thru December Mustard-to November Snap peas-to October Turnips-to November
<b>Veggies For Fall Transplants</b>	Broccoli-thru December Brussel Sprouts-thru December Cabbage-to November Cauliflower-thru December Collards-thru December Garlic Cloves-to mid- November Kohlrabi-to November Kale-to November Mustard-to January Swiss Chard Seeds-Carrots-mid October-Nov Transplants-onion &spinach -October
